The South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT) in conjunction with McCook County will hold an open house style public meeting to discuss and receive public input on the preliminary recommendations of a Master Transportation Plan (MTP) being developed for McCook County. The open house will be informal, with one on one discussion available with SDDOT, County & Consultant staff.

The purpose of this meeting is to present highlights and preliminary recommendations for transportation priorities and projects over the next 20+ years. This includes items such as priority truck routes, potential roadway surfacing changes, bridges, bicycle and pedestrian facilities, and funding.

Between 5:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m., SDDOT, County, & Consultant staff will be available with displays to discuss the proposed options and answer your questions. During this time, you will also have the opportunity to present written comments. A short presentation will be given at approximately 5:35 p.m.

A printed copy of the DRAFT MTP report will be available for review at the McCook County Courthouse and Canistota City Hall beginning August 4, 2017. The DRAFT MTP report will also be posted on the project website.
