A presentation will take place shortly after 5:30 p.m. Afterwards, CETEC & SDDOT staff will be available with displays to discuss the proposed project and answer your questions. During this time, you will also have the opportunity to present written comments.

Information will be available on the acquisition of right-of-way and relocation assistance. This project is being developed in compliance with state and federal environmental regulations. Anticipated environmental considerations associated with the Section 4(f) & 6(f) evaluation of Founders Park, Mountain View Soccer Field, Omaha Street Disc Golf Course, and the Rapid City Biking Trail will be discussed.
