Transportation funding, roadway surface type and condition, bridge priorities, bicycle and pedestrian accommodations, safety concerns, and guidelines for future development are all elements of the McCook County transportation network that will be discussed as part of the Master Transportation Plan (MTP). ## Study Overview

The South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT), McCook County, and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) have partnered in the preparation of a long-range (20+ years) Master Transportation Plan for McCook County. The multi-modal study is currently in the preliminary stages of gathering information that will help define the current transportation issues, needs, and opportunities within McCook County.

## Study Schedule

Gather information and perform baseline conditions analyses *Aug-Dec 2016*  
*Public involvement to assist identifying issues and needs*

Develop roadway standards and design guidelines *Oct-Dec 2016*

Analyze future transportation needs and funding *Dec 2016-Jan 2017*

Develop recommendations to address needs *Feb-Mar 2017*

Develop Master Transportation Plan *Feb-June 2017*  
*Public involvement to review and provide feedback on MTP recommendations*
