

Custer Area Construction Projects – September 2018

Concrete Pavement Repair, Various Locations – This project began at the beginning of September. Traffic will experience minimal delays. The completion date is November 2, 2018

- The following locations will be controlled with stop signs:
 - US 18 from Wyoming to 1.5 miles west of Edgemont,
 - US 385 one location toward the north end of Hot Springs,
 - US 385 over Pactola Dam,
- These locations will be controlled with a lane closer. Traffic will normally remain continuous with reduced speed:
 - US 18 one location in Hot Springs by High School,
 - SD 79 near Hermosa

US 18B Hot Springs Truck Bypass and US 18P in Edgemont – A roadway lighting project is scheduled to begin on May 21. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in various locations along the route throughout the duration of the project. The completion date is October 12, 2018.

US 385 from Pringle to Custer, US 16 from Custer to JCT with US 16A (Keystone Wye), and US 18 West of Jct with SD 79 for two miles – **Areas that have existing asphalt surfacing will be excluded** – A concrete pavement repair and crack sealing project will begin before the end of June. Traffic will be reduced to 2 lanes within segments that currently have 3 or more lanes of traffic. Traffic will be reduced to 1 lane within segments that currently have 2 lanes and will be controlled with stop signs/signals and/or flaggers and pilot car. The completion date is November 2, 2018.

US 18 Bridge over Red Canyon Creek, 2.5 miles East of Edgemont – A project to repair the concrete approach slabs and asphalt pavement began at the beginning of August. The project will be reduced to one lane and will be controlled by a temporary traffic signal. The completion date for this project is October 5, 2018.
